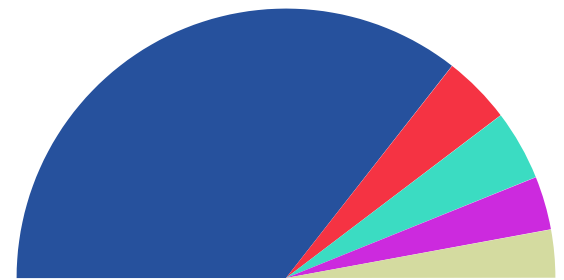

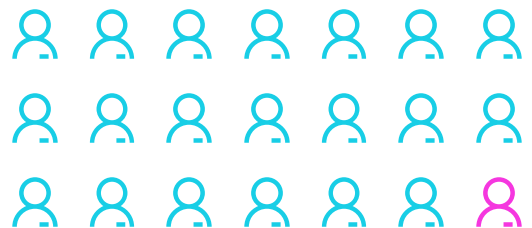
Number of Heavy Vehicle Licences Granted in WA up to 1 March 2022



56.4% of Heavy Vehicle Licence holders in Western Australia have their Heavy Rigid (HR) licence

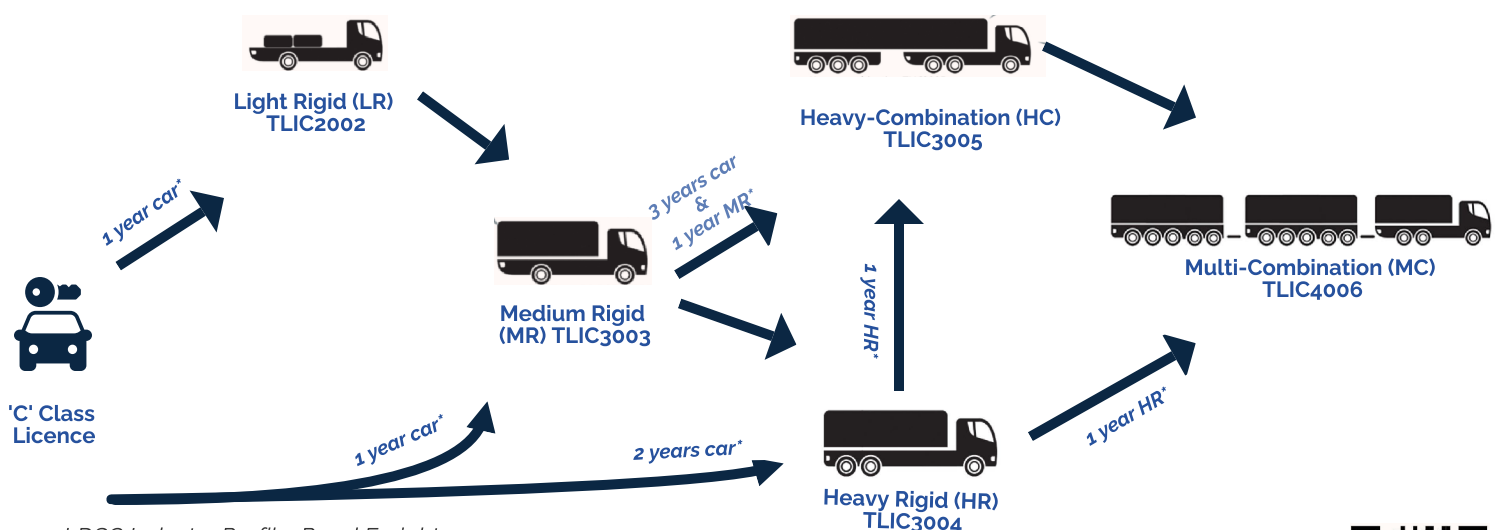

** To progress through the licences, each licence must be held for a minimum amount of time before progressing (i.e. 1 year car licence). A MC Licence can only be achieved once a HR licence has been held for at least 1 year at a minimum.*
