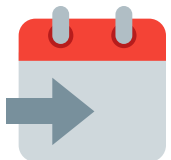

On-demand Drivers must be at least 20 years of age to apply for a Passenger Transport Authorisation (PTD).

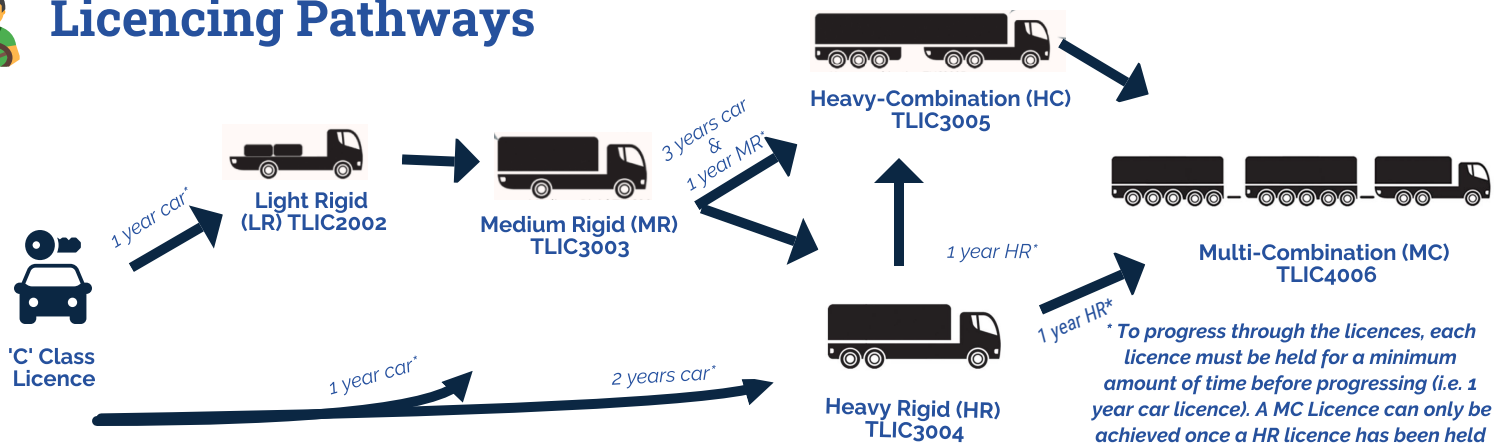
