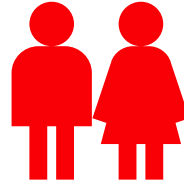

Rise in Industry Revenue



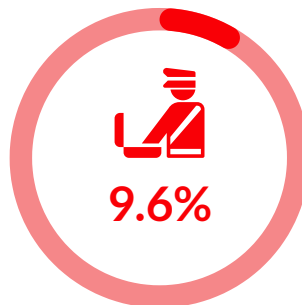
\$5.9 BN

is the revenue for industry in 2022 a rise of 08% growth year on year. This is projected to increase with the rise in demand for e-commerce as warehousing space increases.

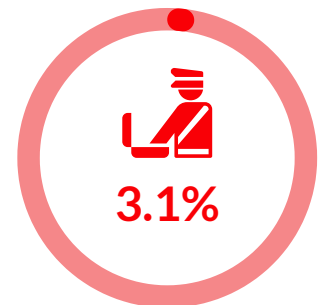
